Between 14th -17th November 1 leader from Slovakia, uk, poland and 2 from rumania meet in Alicante to talk and decide about he next meetings, results, dissemintation, etc about the project Re-Pro-Tradition that will run during the next 2 years with the partners from england, Poland, Rumania, Slovakia and Spain.

In this meeting (2 working days) we have time to talk and to visit different places in alicante and Elche, discover different cultures things, taste and to discover traditional food from alicante región, also we visit – Feria de la Gastronomia- in alicante, we we taste and see food product from all spain.

We did a very good job and we arrange all the things for the next month and the next mobilities.

### Meeting in Poland 18-22 April 2012

Mobility organized in Poland was connected with workshop and sport in the context of tradition.

We were discussing about huge role of tradition in everyday life and gave chance for each country to show traditional games. Thanks those activities we found common background. On the first day, the participants were introduced to each other with using activating methods (ice breakers, name games) in order to create an atmosphere of trust and understanding. The first workshop dealt with different concepts and understandings of sport in the context of tradition, while the next session provided the participants with deeper knowledge about the polish ceramics tradition. During ceramics workshops participants produced clay tablets, they had also possibility to find out more about history and types of materials used in manual production process. This exercise proved that traditions are still cultivated and could be interesting, regardless of age of participants. To widen ways of intercultural learning we showed participants Olympic Sport Museum and Sport Exhibition. The mobility finished with the evaluation and free time in order to give a possibility to explore Warsaw's other traditional or historic places.
